

How do I fit CTE classes in my 4-year plan?

The Michigan Merit Curriculum graduation requirements result in very full schedules for high school students so scheduling CTE classes requires a little creativity. Here are some options to consider allowing more room in your schedule for CTE classes.

- 1) Take a designated CTE class as your fourth/final year math requirement.
- 2) Take a required semester class (Physical Education, Health, Civics, Economics) in a summer school program. You may choose to do this more than one summer!
- 3) Take one required class online.
- 4) Take a required class 0 or 7 hour.

Remember, the key to real choice is doing well in all your classes. Meet your challenges by taking opportunities to receive extra help when needed. When you have to repeat a class, it minimizes choice.
